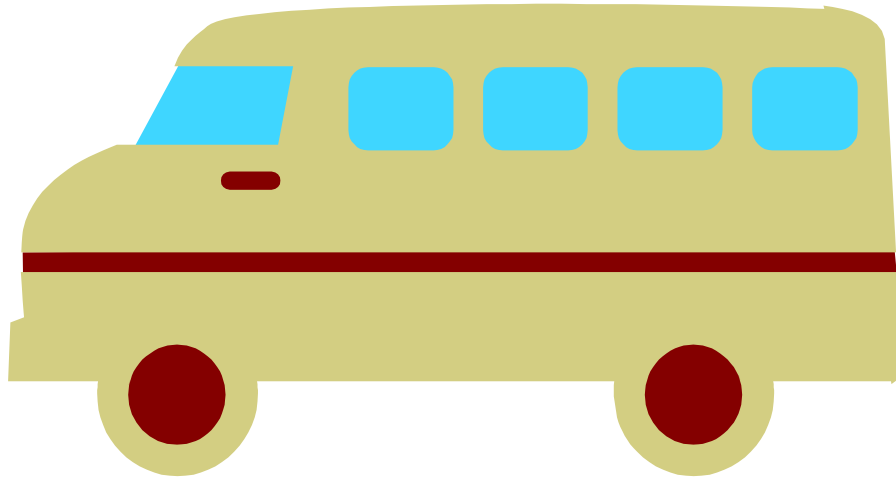


MAYO CLINIC SHUTTLE INFORMATION



1. The Shuttle is called “Saint Mary’s Patient Shuttle”(operated by Gold Cross Ambulance) (this is a free service, no tipping allowed)
2. It runs Monday through Friday, no holidays.
3. It runs from St. Mary’s hospital to the Mayo Gonda Building and back to St. Mary’s hospital. A continual loop all day.
4. **Schedule:**
 - **From 6:40-8 AM:** The shuttle comes automatically 2-3 times.
 - **From 8AM-5:15PM:** Stop at the Reception Desk and ask for it to be called. (Please indicate the # of riders, if going to St. Mary’s or Gonda and if any riders are in wheelchairs.)
5. You may wait 2-30 minutes for the shuttle to arrive. (plan ahead)
6. You **MUST** be in the reception area ready / waiting and looking for the shuttle to arrive.
7. When coming back from Mayo: go to the West door of the Gonda Building and listen for “St Mary’s Patient Shuttle”. When on the shuttle, please ask the driver to let you off at the Gift of Life House (NORTH for 705 building and SOUTH for 724 building).
